

PUTTING THE MARCH 2021 PYGMY POSSUM COVID REGULATIONS AND SAFETY PLAN INTO ACTION

Although the current Regulations and Club COVID Safety Plan allow greater flexibility, Members and their Guests must understand that the situation could change at any time and that lockdowns and hot spots could affect the Club's ability to provide accommodation. If this occurs bookings will have to be modified on a last in first out basis. Also note, unrelated individuals cannot share bedrooms under COVID thus all single person bookings will be charged the single supplement and have their own private room

Until otherwise advised Pygmy Possum Lodge will:

1. Operate at, or near, full capacity depending on group mix
2. Expect guests to follow the directions of the Lodge Captains or COVID Safety Officer in complying with the Safety Plan and its application.
3. Encourage minimal contact between individuals from unrelated groups by Social Distancing as much as possible. This will be facilitated by:
 - a. Maintaining the distancing between dining tables established in 2020
 - b. Having only two lounge suites per dining room as in 2020, and
 - c. Limiting numbers in line with signage in constricted areas; including kitchens (3 unrelated groups only at a time), drying rooms (4 people) and quiet rooms (4 people).
4. Expect all guests to clean and sanitize their bedroom and en-suite bathrooms on arrival and all hard surface work areas, tables, equipment etc, after use. In addition, they will take their turn in cleaning and sanitizing contact surfaces in common areas (stair rails, light switches, door handles etc).
5. Expect common area surface cleaning and sanitizing to be done at least once per day and recorded on the record sheet.
6. Expect all guests to be familiar with the principles set out in the Lodge COVID Safety Plan.
