

YOUR GUIDE TO SELF MANAGED COVID-19 SAFETY AT PYGMY POSSUM LODGE

Outside the Ski Season there will not be a resident Covid Safety Officer. Keeping Covid Safe is not that difficult but requires attention to social distancing and cleaning and sanitisation. The detailed Covid Safety Plan is available on all dining tables. Please read it so that you better understand the principles of how to protect yourselves and others. During the Ski Season the Lodge and records were inspected by a Dept of Health Officer. It is important that all documentation is kept up to date in the **Covid Record Sheet** for your week to ensure we can continue to operate as a Covid Safe facility.

General

- **On arrival** cover all bedroom linen with your own linen to ensure isolation from previous users and those after you. Sanitise surfaces as a precaution. Not all guests will be as reliable as you.
- **On departure** all surfaces in bedrooms and common areas should be cleaned and sanitised so that incoming guests are protected. See **Covid Record Sheet** for details.
- The Lodge is well provided with **spray cleaners and sanitisers for surface cleaning and hand sanitisers** on all levels.
- Opening windows and doors to increase ventilation is recommended to reduce aerosol infection risk.
- It is unlikely that you will have casual visitors outside the Ski Season but if you do their details and times of visit must be recorded on the Covid Record Sheet to facilitate tracing if needed.

Wing Scenario 1

A family group or a group of friends in close contact at home, or when travelling to Charlottes Pass occupy the wing with no other group(s).

- Social distancing within the wing not relevant but is with residents of the other wing.
- Games room surfaces and equipment will require regular cleaning and sanitising.
- Record cleaning and sanitising on the Record Sheet.

Wing Scenario 2

Multiple unrelated groups are resident in the same wing. Social distancing is now important. To minimize the chance of cross contamination:

- Each group should use only one table or a group of tables as needed and **not share tables**. This becomes your group's table(s) for the duration of your stay.
- Similarly, each group should use the same stove, sink and food preparation and food storage areas (including fridge and freezers) and not share if at all possible (e.g. max 3 unrelated groups). This becomes your groups stove and food prep and storage areas for the duration of your stay.
- The better isolated your group areas the lower the infection risk.
- Cleaning and sanitising common touch surfaces (benches, handrails, appliances, light switches, etc) each day as set out in the Covid Record Sheet.
- Recording that you have cleaned and sanitised on the Record Sheet.
